All,

## All Things New

Growing up in Michigan and Rhode Island I experienced very distinct seasons. Summer was filled with warm weather, playing outside, trips to the beach to swim, and picnics. Fall was when school would start, leaves would change color, and coolness filled the air. Playing outside was still thoroughly enjoyable, but trips to the beach were to walk the beach rather than to swim. In winter when we lived in Michigan my uncle would use a bulldozer to add a huge pile of snow to an existing hill. It created a beautiful place for sledding! The snow would melt and spring would come. I remember looking for the first “robin red-breast” that would signify that spring was truly on its way. The world would transform from a white and gray to splashes of bright colors all over the place! Even the sky seemed to be a brighter shade of blue in the springtime.

Spring reminds me of God’s promise in *Revelation 21:5* that He is “*making all things new.*” Christ’s death, burial, and resurrection was a turning point in history. 
Training dates begin at 8:30am with food and fellowship, then training begins at 9:00am.


