God's Voice

Do we hear God's voice? Think on the question. I believe our Father God is speaking to us constantly. His Word tells us in John 10;27 that "My sheep know my voice, and I know them, and they follow me". If this is so, then why do I often times seem to get so lost in a myriad of bad decisions?

I recently saw a motivational/devotional video about a passenger on a small plane, who had to fly and land the plane on his own, having never done such a thing before (the pilot had become incapacitated). His air traffic controller told him, "you can't see me, but I can see you, and right now my voice is all you have. Just follow my voice." As I said previously, I believe God is speaking all the time. Isaiah 30;21 tells us "And you shall hear a word behind you saying "this is the way, walk in it" when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left". Our Father speaks to us through his written Word, His still small voice, our spiritual leaders who have authority in our lives, through circumstances, through other believers, I believe He even uses non-believers to get my attention sometimes.

I say all this to make a point. You may/may not be hearing God's voice like you think you should, but either way, lean into Him. Turn off the TV, or the iPhone, or whatever it may be that reminds you of the cares of this world. We all must work and attend to our commitments, but try this for a consistent, committed period of time, and listen to what He tells you. (Jesus called this the prayer closet) You might be surprised at how well you DO hear His voice.
