



Town Hall Meeting Summary

We held the planned Town Hall meeting on Saturday July 13th at Brunswick First UMC. We had approximately 50 attendees, many who shared their hearts for our Community and the Board appreciated each person who spoke.

The Board met after the Town Hall, counting the ballots; the vote tally was - 31 laity/board members and 3 clergy voted to continue our community while 15 voted to disestablish. Of the yes votes received there were 8 willing to serve on the board; 10 willing to sponsor; 18 willing to serve on a background team and/or a Conference room team.

The Board voted to honor the yes votes received and continue our Golden Isles Emmaus Community. We have a lot of work ahead of us, part of this work is our vision to host a Day Four Restore event. This is an all-day event to reengage our community as we work toward being able to again hold walks. More information will be coming on this event in the next few months.

The Board will also be reviewing and updating our community's By-Laws to be current and relevant.
